JUNIOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

AUGUST 20th/21st

The National Fireball Junior Championship for 1977 was held at Llangorse Sailing Club during the weekend of August 20th / 21st, sponsored by Bulmers Apple Juice. It was the first time that Llangorse had been host to this meeting and they were very pleased with the response. 28 boats took part, with entries from all over the country including places as far apart as Cumbria and Suffolk, and even one entry from Hong Kong!

A particularly pleasing aspect of the entries was the fact that 11 of the boats entered had crews and helms who were both under the qualifying age of 19. In fact both the first and second boats came into this category.

There was a light breeze at the start of the practice race on Saturday morning which freshened as the race progressed. This race was won by Paul Collins and his crew Richard Schooling from South Cerney Sailing Club.

During the lunch break the wind strengthened, suggesting that there might have been some good sailing in store. However this did not materialise and from then on the wind died away to almost a flat calm.

At the end of the first day, after two races, Peter Tozer with crew John Peperell from R.P.C.Y.C. was in the lead with David Jarrett and his brother Ian from Llandegfedd in strong contention and Duncan Howie (Llangorse) lying third. At this stage only one point separated Alan Titmus (Llandegfedd), Robert Stark (Chew Valley Lake) and Graham Eeles (Broxbourne) in fourth, fifth and sixth places.

On Sunday, although the day dawned bright and sunny, the wind had not improved and sailing was frustrating all day. After the third race Peter Tozer was still in the lead with David Jarrett % point behind. Meanwhile Michael Hart (Lake District Boat Club) with crew Billy Bell had moved up into the placings.

A very bad result in the fourth race meant that Peter Tozer had to win the last race in order to clinch the Trophy from David Jarrett. Instead the last race was won by Graham Eeles, placing him second overall. David Jarrett came fifth, and in so doing won the Championship.

It is of great credit to the Jarrett boys that not only have they won this championship in very light airs, they were also second at Llangorse in the Welsh Youth Championship held earlier this year in gale force conditions.
