

Davies nowhere; but he lost his chance by going the wrong way on the run and dropped to 6th, the Grays taking over the important third place. After a beat and a reach Bagley was back at fourth, but however hard he tried he couldn't get back to third.

Up front the lead changed hands frequently. Hawker was back in front at the end of the second beat and was 20 seconds clear by the end of the

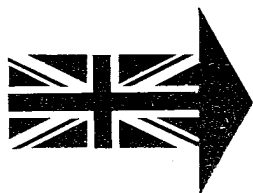
run. Another beat and Sandy and he were level and on the next reach Sandy's extra speed got him in front. But on the fourth beat Hawker got ahead, then lost it by tacking on the wrong shift. He got ahead again on the final beat, but then there was an added worry. The Grays had made a long port tack and as they came towards the finish line on starboard it looked as though they might well be in front. With a hundred yards to

go Hawker and Sandy were level as Gray came to join the fight for the front. Only a boat's length separated the three at the line with Sandy getting the verdict and the Marlow Trophy by a second from Hawker.

With Bagley out of the first three and Davies out of the hunt, Brackwell, who was 8th, took the championship, but only one point separated the first three and 6 points the first 6.
